

Privacy Notice – The Glitch Camp

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter “GDPR”), and in relation to the personal data that the Francesco Morelli Foundation will process following your registration for the project “The Glitch Camp”, we hereby inform you as follows.

Data Controller and Data Protection Contact

The Data Controller is the Francesco Morelli Foundation (hereinafter the “Foundation” or the “Data Controller”), with registered office in Milan, Via Amatore Sciesa, 20135 Milan, Italy.

Categories of Personal Data Processed

Depending on the circumstances, the Foundation may process the following categories of personal data:

1. Personal identification data (first name, last name, date of birth, address);
2. Contact details (telephone number, email address);
3. Copies of identity documents and university ID cards.

Purposes and Legal Basis of Processing

The processing of personal data is necessary for the following purposes:

- selection procedures for participation in the project and management of related communications, including accommodation confirmation
(legal basis: performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or pre-contractual measures taken at the request of the data subject, pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR);
- compliance with legal, regulatory, or authority requirements
(legal basis: compliance with a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject, pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR);
- exercise of the Data Controller’s rights, including, for example, the right of defense in legal proceedings
(legal basis: legitimate interest pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

Nature of Data Provision and Consequences of Failure to Provide Data

The provision of personal data is optional; however, failure to provide the requested data will result in the inability to participate in the project.

Methods of Processing

Processing is carried out by means of operations such as collection, recording, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, blocking, communication, erasure, and destruction of data, in compliance with applicable legal provisions (Regulation (EU) 2016/679).

Personal data will be processed in written form and/or by magnetic, electronic, or telematic means solely for the purposes outlined above.

Your data will be processed by duly trained personnel and collaborators formally authorized to process personal data.

Your personal data will not be subject to any fully automated decision-making process, including profiling, nor will they be subject to dissemination, except where such dissemination is required to comply with legal or regulatory obligations.

Data Retention

Your personal data processed for the purposes indicated above will be retained for the duration of your stay in the accommodations provided for the project, unless otherwise required by applicable legal obligations of the Data Controller.

Disclosure of Data

Your personal data may be accessed and used within the Foundation by authorized personnel and may also be disclosed to third parties, who will process such data within the scope of their respective responsibilities, acting, as applicable, either as independent Data Controllers or as Data Processors.

Such third parties may include, by way of example: consultants providing services related to the project, banking and insurance institutions, judicial or administrative authorities for compliance with legal obligations, IT system administrators, and IT service providers responsible for system maintenance and backup management.

Transfer of Data Abroad

The Data Controller will not transfer personal data to third countries or international organizations. Should such transfer become necessary, the Data Controller will ensure the existence of an adequacy decision by the European Commission or the adoption of appropriate safeguards.

Data Subject Rights

Pursuant to Articles 15 to 22 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you may exercise, at any time, the rights provided therein, including the right of access, rectification, erasure,

restriction of processing, data portability, objection, and the right to be informed about processing carried out by automated decision-making processes relating to natural persons, including profiling.
