*Scholarship application call for the right to education- DSU
First and Second Level Academic Diploma Courses
Academic Year 2026/2027*

The official document ("**Bando di concorso per l'assegnazione di Borse di Studio per il diritto allo studio Universitario Anno Accademico 2026/2027**") is written in Italian.

This drafted in English language is only meant to be a mere courtesy translation.

As a consequence, the Italian version of the document shall prevail in any case



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1. THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION

The right to study is enshrined in articles 3 and 34 of the Italian constitution and offers gifted and deserving students, including those without sufficient economic means, the possibility to attain the highest levels of education. Italian Regional (Lombardy) Law (l.r.) no. 33 of 13/12/2004 governs the system of interventions aimed at implementing the right to education and higher education in art, music and dance (AFAM).

Benefits for students enrolled in a first level academic diploma course consist in the provision of scholarships, assigned through an application call issued in compliance with (Lombardy) l.r. no. 33 of 13/12/2004, and article 3 of the decree of the President of the Council of Ministers (d.p.c.m.) of 9/4/2001, implementing art. 4 of Law (l.) no. 390 of 2/12/1991, also in light of Legislative Decree (d.lgs.) no. 109 of 31/03/1998, governing ISEE (Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation) as a parameter for evaluating the economic conditions of scholarship applicants, and additional applicable laws and regulations including the Lombardy Regional Council Resolution (d.G.r) no. XII/6298 of 15/06/2026 providing «Determinations regarding allocation criteria and funding for the awarding of competitive benefits for the right to education – academic year 2026-2027».

To guarantee the right to study, IED coordinates, organises and grants in favour of those eligible:

- a) interventions and services aimed at the implementation of the right to study according to (Lombardy) l.r. no. 33 of 13/12/2004;
- b) develops and proposes an additional offering of interventions and services to facilitate participation in its study courses.

In addition, IED promotes all those interventions which help to improve living and study conditions.

These interventions also include scholarships pursuant to l.r. no. 33/2004

- interventions for international mobility and international exchanges
- library service - newspaper & periodicals archive – video library and free book lending service
- cultural and social activities
- study tutors
- work guidance/internship service

2. APPLICANTS ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

Applications for a scholarship may be presented by:

- Italian citizens
- citizens of a European Union member state
- citizens of non-European Union countries (d.p.r. no. 394 of 31/08/1999, inter alia art. 44 bis, implementing d.lgs no. 286 of 25/07/1998, also para.5, art. 46 of d.p.r. no. 394 of 31/08/1999)

who meet all the following requirements:

- they are an IED student, admitted or enrolled¹, in a **First Level Academic Diploma or Second Level Academic Diploma** courses at Istituto Europeo di Design, in the seats of **Milan, Rome, Turin, Cagliari or Florence**, for the Academic Year **2026/2027**;
- they have the economic and merit requirements listed below at point 4.

To be considered eligible for the scholarship students must meet the academic requirements with reference to the very first year of enrolment. For this purpose, the student shall state in his/her application the presence of any previous events (withdrawal from studies, passage to another course, transfer from another university, degree, etc.) leading to academic irregularity.

Calculation of the first enrolment will be applied with reference to the qualification level for enrolment in the academic year 2026-2027, identifying the entitlement to access this level as a criterion for calculating any previous career. Therefore, enrolment in a First Level Academic Diploma is, for this purpose only, equivalent to enrolment in a Bachelor's degree course, sharing the same access qualification (high school diploma).

In the event, therefore, that during their overall career, the student has had to repeat a course year for the same level of study attended during the academic year 2026-2027, including after the renewal of the enrolment after withdrawing from a course/forfeiting at any Italian or foreign university, the number of credits required to access the ranking for the scholarship will be calculated with reference to the credits envisaged for each year, starting with the first year of enrolment, with the exception of the years in which studies were suspended.

¹ **Access to scholarships and to the enjoyment of benefits and services pertaining to the right to study are restricted to students who are regularly enrolled in the academic year 2026/2027.**

Note that in order to be "regularly enrolled", students must, as provided by IED General Regulations, be in order with their academic requirements and administrative position, paying enrolment and tuition fee by:

- **September 30, 2026** students enrolled in the 2nd and 3rd year - First and Second Level Academic Diploma
- **October 31, 2026** students enrolled in the 1st year - First and Second Level Academic Diploma

Students not duly in order by the above dates will not be considered eligible for obtaining the benefits and will not be included in the temporary ranking list for access to a scholarship.

Following the entry into force of law no. 33/2022, double simultaneous enrolment in two degree courses is now permitted. Pending the issuance of the related implementing decrees, art. 3 of law no. 33/2022, however, provides that the student who enrolls in two study courses at the same time benefits from the tools and services in support of the right to study for a single enrolment, elected by the student himself/herself.

Students must therefore declare in the scholarship application any double enrolment (or the intention to enrol, also in another University /AFAM) and for which enrolment they intend to use the services of the right to education.

Failure to indicate this information correctly will result in forfeiture of the scholarship granted or provided by IED and the possible imposition of penalties provided for by art. 10, para. 3 of d.lgs. 68/2012.

Pursuant to art. 6, para. 3 of the MUR Ministerial Decree (D.M.) no. 1320/2021, students with double enrolment are entitled to a 20% increase in the amount of the scholarship as long as they maintain the requirements for the scholarship itself, as set out in this call.

Under penalty of exclusion, the scholarship application call is not open to students enrolled in IED courses for the Academic Year 2026/2027 who:

- have already achieved, in Italy or abroad, qualifications equivalent or higher than the course of study for which they are requesting the benefits and services for the academic year. 2026/2027;
- hold or have held — even partially — for the same year a scholarship (or comparable form of economic aid related to consideration of income conditions or study results or a combination of both) awarded by IED or other public or private institutions);
- have enrolled in a First or Second Level Academic Diploma course at IED, after applying for the withdrawal from studies, forfeiture, transfer etc. at IED or another university/institute, regardless of the time elapsed since the previous application;
- change the seat of study, repeating the enrolment in a course year already attended;
- have enrolled in a foreign university and are eligible to attend a course at IED, under International Exchange program agreements (*Erasmus/Exchange*);
- have enrolled in IED *Foundation* Courses for the academic year 2026/2027.

N.B.: please read the details provided in note 1 of this call.

3. ALLOCATION FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

For the academic year 2026/2027, Istituto Europeo di Design, based on the estimated funding assigned by Lombardy Regional Council Resolution (d.G.R.) no. XII/6298 of 15/06/2026, will award scholarships for a total value of **Euro 457.047,02**.

After receipt of all scholarship applications, the allocated sum for scholarships for all activated courses will be distributed on a percentage basis, taking into account the number of enrolled students participating in the call, divided into the following rankings:

- ✓ **RANKING 1** - students enrolled for the first time in the first year of a First level Academic Diploma Course
- ✓ **RANKING 2** - students enrolled in the 2nd and 3rd year of a First level Academic Diploma Course
- ✓ **RANKING 3** - students enrolled in the 2nd year of a Second Level Academic Diploma Course
- ✓ **RANKING 4** - students enrolled for the first time in the first year of a Second Level Academic Diploma Course

The financing comes from awards set aside by the MUR (Ministry of University and Research) and the Lombardy Region.

4. ACCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP RANKING LISTS

4.1. Merit requirements

In order to be admitted to the ranking list, applicants must:

Students enrolled in the 1st year - First Level Academic Diploma

- **be regularly enrolled² for the Academic Year 2026/2027, for the first time in the first year of a First Level Academic Diploma course at IED, by October 31, 2026;**
- **have obtained an Upper Secondary School Diploma** with a grade equal to or greater than **80/100 (66/100** students with disabilities of 66% or above or with a recognized handicap pursuant the art.3 paragraph 1 Law 104/92).
Students with a diploma from outside Italy will be assessed according to the diploma grade resulting from the document that must be submitted and with the application of conversion

formula adopted by the MUR.³ - Students with a Diploma from outside Italy will have to present as well the Declaration of Value.

- **meet the economic requirements** as stated below at point 4.2

In addition, **the total confirmation** of benefits, as specified at art. 10 ("Assignment of scholarships and payment terms") is subject to obtaining at least **40 credits** by no later than **August 10, 2027**.

Students enrolled in 2nd or 3rd year– First Level Academic Diploma

- **be regularly enrolled**⁴ for the Academic Year 2026/2027, in the second or third year of a First Level Academic Diploma course at IED, by **September 30, 2026**;
- have obtained by no later than **August 10, 2026**
 - ✓ at least **40 credits** (only for students enrolling in the 2nd year)
 - ✓ at least **100 credits** (only for students enrolling in the 3rd year)
- **meet the economic requirements** as stated below at point 4.2

In addition, **the total confirmation** of benefits, as specified at point 10 ("Assignment of scholarships and payment terms") is subject to obtaining by no later than **August 10, 2027**:

- ✓ **100 credits** (only for students enrolling in the **2nd year**)
- ✓ **160 credits** (only for students enrolling in the **3rd year**)

Students enrolled in the 1st year - Second Level Academic Diploma

- **be regularly enrolled**⁵ for the Academic Year 2026/2027 **for the first time in the first year** of a Second Level Academic Diploma course at IED, by **October 31, 2026**;
- **have achieved** a Bachelor's Degree or First Level Academic Diploma by **January 31, 2027**. Students will have to present the application for a scholarship by the general deadline of **November 6, 2026**, declaring their intention to enrol in the case they haven't achieved yet the First Level study title. Students with a Diploma from outside Italy will have to present as well the Declaration of Value.
- **meet the economic requirements** as stated below at point 4.2

In addition, **the total confirmation** of benefits, as specified at art. 10 ("Assignment of scholarships and payment terms") is subject to obtaining at least **40 credits** by no later than **August 10, 2027**.

Students enrolled in 2nd year – Second Level Academic Diploma

- **be regularly enrolled⁶** for the Academic Year 2026/2027, in the second year of a Second Level Academic Diploma course at IED, by **September 30, 2026**;
- have obtained at least **40 credits** no later than **August 10, 2026**;
- **meet the economic requirements** as stated below at point 4.2

In addition, **the total confirmation** of benefits, as specified at art. 10 ("Assignment of scholarships and payment terms") is subject to obtaining at least **100 credits** by no later than **August 10, 2027**.

PLEASE NOTE:

- with regard to the payment's terms and withdrawal of the benefit, see point 10 below;
- with regard to the cases of incompatibility and forfeiture, see point 11 below.

Students with disabilities

For students with invalidity above 66% or with a recognised *handicap* pursuant to Art.3, para. 1 of Law 104/92, enrolled for the first time in the first year of a First Level Academic Diploma course, merit requirements can be reconsidered, based on the type of disability, and requirements may deviate by the stated values by up to a maximum of 40%. The merit requirements will be established by a dedicated IED internal commission.

All students enrolled in a 2nd or in a 3rd year, when completing the on-line application, will be required to indicate the number of academic credits attained and the corresponding weighted average. These values are to be understood as follows:

- ✓ **Number of academic credits:** students are required to specify the number of academic credits they have earned by passing exams and which have been duly recorded since the beginning of their academic history (for the current level of studies), by **August 10, 2026**. Any credits earned from exams not included in study plans, or from exams taken and recorded prior to matriculation on the current level of studies are not valid.
- ✓ **Weighted average:** students are required to calculate and specify the weighted average of the exams listed in the "*NUMBER OF CREDITS ATTAINED*" field; exam marks not expressed in thirtieths should not be considered. **30 with honours (cum laude) should be counted as 30.**

PLEASE NOTE:

In the case of grades with honors, the weighted average shown on IED CAMPUS must be recalculated according to the following criteria

To obtain the weighted average, each mark should be multiplied by the exam value (in credits); the total of the results should be divided by the total number of academic credits considered.

Bonus:

Students who fail to attain the minimum number of credits required may add the bonus credits specified below to the academic credits actually attained, as follows:

- 5 credits, if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the second academic year;
- 12 credits, if used for the first time to obtain benefits for the third academic year.

The *bonus* may be used once and may not be combined. Any bonus not used during the academic year of reference may be used in following academic years.

Any *bonus* accrued and not used during the First Level Academic Diploma course may be transferred for the enrolment in a Second Level Academic Diploma course.

4.2. Economic requirements

The financial status of the household of students applying for a scholarship will be identified based on the **Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator** for benefits provided in support of the Right to Education (**ISEEU-ISPEU parificato**) ex art. 8 of DPCM no. 159/2013.

The economic position of foreign students or of Italian students resident abroad is calculated in accordance with art. 8, para. 5, of d.p.c.m. no. 159/2013, without prejudice to various provisions issued at national level.

The economic and financial position of foreign students from non-European Union countries is calculated in accordance with the provisions of d.lgs. no. 286 (art.4, para. 3 and 39) of 25/07/1998, and d.p.r. no. 394 (art. 46, para. 5) of 31/08/1999.

To be considered as meeting the income requirements needed to request a scholarship, students must have an ISEEU-ISPEU parificato in which:

- ✓ **the ISEEU** Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator **does not exceed € 26.887,93**
- ✓ **the ISPEU** Equivalent Asset Situation Indicator (calculated by operators and corresponding to ISPU / equivalence scale, as per Section I, Method of calculation of ordinary ISEE for the certificate for benefits relating to education) **does not exceed €58.452,06.**

Both of the above-mentioned index ceilings must be observed; if even just one of the two indexes exceeds the respective ceiling, the student will be deemed as not fulfilling the economic requirements and will not be approved for access to the benefit.

To make it easier to obtain **ISEEU-ISPEU parificato**, foreign students can request the certification from the following CAAF which has stipulated an agreement with IED:

Under penalty of exclusion from the call, for the academic year 2026/2027, the **ISEEU-ISPEU parificato** must be grounded on income in the relevant year and on the value of movable and immovable assets owned as at **31.12** of the relevant year by the student's family. Foreign students are nevertheless required to declare the presence of any income and assets held in Italy by their family.

For the academic year 2026/2027, the relevant year is **2024** for students applying for the first enrolment to an undergraduate and postgraduate course; the relevant year is **2025** for students applying for an enrolment renewal to an undergraduate and postgraduate course;

Students will be required to present the following documentation:

- Valid identity card or passport and Tax Code
- Family status declaration (i.e. a statement of all the family members living in the same house);
- Income tax return of each family member in the relevant year. The figure must be converted to Euro taking into consideration the average exchange rate of the relevant year;
- Properties nationally owned by the family (in square meters) at 31.12 of the relevant year;
- Personal estate of the family owned at December 31.12. of the relevant year (assets, dividends, etc.);
- Bank account balance at December 31.12 of the relevant year;

- Documentation related to any properties/income the student or the student's family might have in Italy;

Please be advised that documents issued by employers will not be accepted. The official income tax return must be issued by the official government revenue agency of the student's country of residence.

All the documents must be:

- **Translated into Italian by a recognized translator and legalized by the competent local authority in the residing Country.** The student may address to the Italian Diplomatic Representation for any information. (As an alternative, it is possible to have the documents translated by the student's home Country's Embassy or Consulate in Italy and legalized by the Italian Prefettura).
- **Issued after**
 - January, 1 2025 for students applying for the first enrolment to an undergraduate and postgraduate course;
 - January, 1 2026 for students applying for an enrolment renewal to an undergraduate and postgraduate course

Where to submit the documents:

- students applying for the first enrolment to an undergraduate and postgraduate course shall send the ISEE documents **to their IED advisor**;
- students applying for an enrolment renewal to an undergraduate and postgraduate course can send the ISEE documents to the CAF office in charge - **documenti.ied@cgil.lombardia.it**. In the email students will have to specify, along with their name and surname:
 - ✓ that they are IED Students
 - ✓ the matriculation number
 - ✓ the name of the course

COUNTRIES EXEMPT FROM THE LEGALIZATION (irrespective of the place of issue):

COUNTRIES FOR WHICH DOCUMENTS ARE EXEMPT FROM THE CONSULAR/DIPLOMATIC STAMP OF THE ITALIAN EMBASSY BUT REQUIRE AN APOSTILLE STAMP:

Monaco, Reunion, Republic of Korea (formerly South Korea), Romania, Russia, Saint Christopher and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Helena, Serbia-Montenegro, Seychelles, Suriname, Sweden, Swaziland, United States, South Africa, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Ukraine, Vanuatu, Venezuela, British Virgin Islands.

FOREIGN STUDENTS COMING FROM PARTICULARLY POOR COUNTRIES:

Afghanistan, Angola, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Cape Verde, Chad, Comoros, North Korea, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ivory Coast, Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Equatorial Guinea, Haiti, Kenya, Kiribati, Lao Peoples Democratic Republic, Laos, Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Maldives, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Niger, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Samoa, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands, Somalia, Sudan, Tajikistan, Tanzania, East Timor, Togo, Tuvalu, Uganda, Uzbekistan, Vanuatu, Vietnam, Yemen, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

The assessment of the economic situation of students coming from one of the countries mentioned above is made on the basis of a certification issued by the Italian Representative in the student's country of origin, which must certify that the student does not belong to a notoriously high-income family. This certificate may also be issued by the foreign university of enrolment linked by agreement or convention with Italian universities or Italian bodies qualified to provide a guarantee of economic coverage, as envisaged by current legislation on the enrolment of foreign students in Italian universities. In this latter case, the certifying body undertakes to repay the grant on the student's behalf in the event of forfeiture of this condition.

REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA AND SWEDEN: different rules apply to these two countries, which both signed up to the European Convention (London, 1968). For citizens of these countries, exemption from legalization of documents applies only to those documents issued by the diplomatic and consular authorities (present in Italy).

ALBANIA: from 1st July 2011, the Albanian documents which must be produced in Italy no longer need to be previously legalized by Italian diplomatic-consular representatives in Albania, but they must bear the **Apostille** stamp of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Albania. Please refer to the websites of the Italian Embassy in Tirana (<http://www.ambtirana.esteri.it>) and consulates in Scutari (<http://www.consitalia-scutari.org>) and Valona (<http://www.consvalona.esteri.it>) for detailed information about the process that must be followed.

STATELESS STUDENTS OR POLITICAL REFUGEES:

Stateless students or political refugees must attach to their application the official certificate regarding their status of stateless person or refugee, issued by the Italian Ministry of the Interior, or by the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees - Office for Italy (UNHCR Italia).

THE IED DSU OFFICE DOES NOT ACCEPT OR TAKE DELIVERY OF ANY TYPE OF NECESSARY, i.e. PREPARATORY, DOCUMENTATION FOR COMPLETION OF THE University ISEE /ISEEU- parificato FORM. This documentation must be delivered personally by the interested party only and exclusively to INPS or CAAF offices located throughout the country. The IED DSU office will only take delivery of ISEE forms issued definitively by the competent bodies. IED will not be responsible for faults or defects attributable to administrations or to bodies responsible for issuing the above-mentioned documentation.

In any case, the income declared by foreign students cannot be less than **Euro 7.101,12** corresponding to the minimum means of subsistence which must be proven for the purpose of applying for a Visa to enter Italy for study. The above amount is the minimum required in order to evaluate an economic status.

DEFINITION OF "FAMILY UNIT":

- STUDENT LIVING WITH BOTH PARENTS: standard household
- STUDENT LIVING INDEPENDENTLY (**INDEPENDENT STUDENT**): the reference unit for ISEE is that of the student and does not take into account their family of origin.
- NON-INDEPENDENT STUDENT or STUDENT LIVING WITH ONE PARENT ONLY:
 - a) Married and cohabiting parents: the household of reference for ISEE is comprised of the original household and the student.
 - b) Unmarried and non-cohabiting parents:
 - if the non-cohabiting parent pays child maintenance: they are not deemed part of the household.
 - if the non-cohabiting parent is not married and/or does not have children with someone other than the other parent: they are deemed part of the household. They can declare their income in the DSU or present their own ISEE, indicating the relevant details in the University ISEE.
 - if the non-cohabiting parent is married and/or has children with someone other than the other parent: they must present their own ISEE, indicating the relevant details in the University ISEE.

"AUTONOMOUS STUDENT" (INDEPENDENT STUDENT)*

In the case of "independent" students, as defined in accordance with current regulations (see d.p.c.m. of 9/04/2001 and d.p.c.m. 159 of 5/12/2013), income will not be combined with that of their family of origin.

A student is defined as "independent" when they meet all the requirements envisaged by current regulations and, in particular, the following:

1. for at least two years from the date of presentation of the Single Substitute Declaration (DSU), the student's residence must be separate and different compared to the residence of their family of origin;

2. the student's residence must not be in a property owned or enjoyed in usufruct by their family of origin, or in any case, a member of said family (specifically, the student is not deemed independent even if they are only co-owner of the property with at least one member of their family of origin or if at least one family member is owner of another property right or a personal right of enjoyment with respect to the property);
3. presence of an adequate earning capacity, as defined by art. 7, para.7 of Legislative Decree no. 68 of 29 March 2012, meaning specifically that the student must be able to demonstrate a personal income from employment or similar tax-declared income, for at least two years, of not less than **€ 9,000.00** with reference to a household comprised of one person and with the understanding that the work must not be in the employ of a family member.

In the absence of one or both of these requirements, in order to suitably take into consideration those who bear the burden of financial responsibility in relation to the student, the student's household, as per the registry office certificate, will be combined with that of the family of origin, also combining the respective incomes.

If, according to the family status certificate issued by the registry office, the independent student is recorded as cohabiting with another person, income will be considered as the combined sum of the student's income and that of the person with whom they cohabit, even if they are not related by kinship.

5. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The value of the scholarship differs based on:

1. income bracket corresponding to the correct **University ISEEU-ISPEU parificato** of the household
2. student's geographic origin.

Student's geographic origin for all IED seats:

For the purposes of calculating the amount of the scholarship, students are classified as follows:

- **Local student:** students from families residing in the metropolitan area in which the course is taught or who reside in the surrounding area and with public transport, take up to 60 minutes for the daily journey from their home to the place of study (art. 4 comma 8 del DPCM 9 aprile 2001);

- **Commuting student:** resident in a municipality other than that of the courses attended but from where, nonetheless, they can reach the seat of courses attended on a daily basis, with a commute of between 60 to 90 minutes max. using public transport;
- **Distant student⁷:** resident in an area that is distant (more than 90 minutes away by public transport) from the seat of the study course attended, who for this reason **must pay** for an accommodation near the place of study, using public residential structures or private lodgings or those belonging to other bodies, for a period of **not less than 10 months** during the academic year 2026/2027. Without the above conditions, students are considered as “commuters”.

In order to prove the status of “Distant student,” applicants must produce the copy of an official **lease contract**, duly registered in the student’s name or in their parent’s names.

Students residing in public or private structures must produce valid fiscal proof of rent payment for an accommodation located in the same municipality where the study course is based. The official lease contract or valid fiscal proof of rent payment must be submitted by and not later than **December 10, 2026**, before publication of the final ranking list.

Failure to present this documentation will result in the student being classified as “commuting”.

The value of the scholarships, inclusive of the refund of the regional tax for the right to education (equal to Euro 190,00) and the value of one free meal a day (equal to Euro 829,00) is defined as follows:

⁷ According to Art. 13 paragraph 3 of D.P.C.M. 9/04/2001, non-EU students are considered “distant” regardless of their place of residence in Italy, except in the case of their household residing in Italy. For the purpose of the value of the scholarship, the student must **pay for accommodation**.

Students holding a scholarship who do not make use of the food service are not entitled to a refund, except for any duly documented periods of study abroad.

The scholarship can be increased by up to a maximum of 40% of the amount due, in the case of students with a disability greater than 66% and with a recognised handicap pursuant to art. 3 para. 1 of law 104/92, depending on the student's disability, in order to allow the use of prostheses and supports, as well as all interventions that facilitate use of teaching activities and study.

6. SCHOLARSHIP SUPPLEMENTS

There are no supplements for international mobility for the Academic Year 2026/2027.

7. PROCEDURES FOR PREPARING THE RANKING LISTS

Ranking lists are prepared according to the following criteria:

- **Students enrolled in 1st year - First Level Academic Diploma**
- **Students enrolled in 1st year - Second Level Academic Diploma**

Each student who applies for a scholarship is assigned a score based on their economic situation, formulated on the basis of the Equivalent Financial Situation Indicator (**ISEEU - ISPEU parificato**) of their household in relation to a **€ 26.887,93 ceiling**, attributing up to a maximum of 1,000 points using the following formula:

$$1 - \frac{\text{student's ISEE}}{26.887,93} \times 1,000$$

The ranking list is arranged in decreasing order with respect to the points awarded. In the event of equal points, the mark related to the student's qualification takes precedence, after which precedence is given to younger students.

- **Students enrolled in 2nd and 3rd year – First Level Academic Diploma**
- **Students enrolled in 2nd – Second Level Academic Diploma**

The ranking list is arranged in decreasing order with respect to the overall score resulting from the sum of the score related to the number of credits attained or of completed years by **August 10, 2026** and the score resulting from the grade average of exams sat.

A maximum of 1,000 points can be awarded, distributed as follows

- ✓ **600** based on the number of credits attained;
- ✓ **400** based on the average mark achieved in exams passed.

Where merit points are equal, students who have not used their *bonus* will be ranked first, followed by students with the highest score in terms of financial situation. In the event of a further tie, students enrolled in the highest year of the course will be ranked first, followed by the youngest students.

Disabled students with invalidity above 66% and with a recognized handicap pursuant to art. 3, para. 1 of Law 104/92, if in possession of all requirements envisaged by the application call, have the right to be allocated a scholarship even exceeding the number of grants available and will therefore be placed at the top of the rankings and awarded a scholarship.

Method of calculation of score relating to academic merit

The score relating to credits attained by **August 10, 2026** is calculated using the following formula:

$\frac{(\text{Student's credits} - \text{min. credits}) \times 600}{(\text{max credits} - \text{min. credits})}$

The score relating to the average mark of exams passed is calculated using the following formula:

$\frac{(\text{Student's average mark} - \text{Minimum mark}) \times 400}{(18/30) \quad (\text{max mark } 30/30 - \text{min mark } 18/30)}$

7. HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be submitted from September 10, 2026, and strictly by and no later than November 6, 2026. They must be filled in and submitted on-line from the website at the following address: <https://www.ied.edu/admissions/study-in-italy/scholarship-right-to-education>

Students who want to enrol in the first year of the Second Level Academic Diploma courses must submit their application within the same deadlines, even if they have not yet obtained the First Level qualification by that date.

In this case, only students who have obtained a Bachelor's Degree or First Level Academic Diploma from another University in Italy and/or abroad are required to certify the

achievement of their qualification by writing, no later than ten days after obtaining the qualification, to the following email address dsu@milano.ied.it, clearly indicating their identity and contact details.

Following submission of the online application form, students will receive a confirmation e-mail (to the address provided for the registration process), and must print the receipt available in the dedicated section of Student Desk (SPORTELLLO STUDENTI), which must be signed and sent, together with the documents listed below, using one of the following methods:

- **copy of ISEEU-ISPEU “parificato”** for benefits for the right to education, issued in 2026;

Additional documents to be sent according to the student's status, in addition to those previously indicated:

- **only for students enrolling in the 1st year - First Level Academic Diploma a.y. 26/27**: copy of Upper Secondary School Diploma and the Declaration of Value.
- **only for students enrolling in the 1st year - Second Level Academic Diploma a.y. 26/27**: If already obtained a copy of Bachelor's Degree or First Level Academic Diploma or Diploma Supplement and the Declaration of Value.
- **only for all students enrolling in a 2nd and 3rd year a.y. 26/27**: enrolment self-certification with exams achieved by **August 10, 2026** (form downloadable from IED Campus);
- **only for “Distant students”**: copy of the legally registered lease in the name of the student or parent, and copy of rental payment certificate. **This document only, if not available at the date of application, can be presented no later than December 10, 2026** (for details, see paragraph 5);

- **only for students with invalidity levels of at least 66% or handicap recognized pursuant to art. 3 para. 1 Law 104/92:** copy of medical documentation certifying their invalidity;
- **only for non-EU students:** valid residence permit or receipt of the application for residence permit

PLEASE NOTE

The online application submission form does not in any way replace the application submitted in printed form. Failure to submit a document within the prescribed period or the submission of an invalid document will result in exclusion from the scholarship selection process.

Students will, in any case, receive e-mail confirmation of receipt of the documentation. If applicants do not receive such confirmation within 7 days of sending their documents, they must contact the DSU Office:

Students are required to promptly communicate in writing to IED any event regarding their scholarship, and any conditions for obtaining and retaining it, that have occurred after submission of the application form (purely by way of example: receiving another scholarship or financial aid, transferring to another university, starting a job, being unable to continue their study, withdrawal of the enrolment, change in the marital or economic status of the student and others whose income and wealth must be considered for the purpose of awarding the scholarship, etc. ...).

9. PUBLICATION OF THE RANKING LISTS AND APPEALS

Interested parties will be notified of the publication of provisional ranking lists no sooner than:

- **November 27, 2026** – all students enrolled in the First Level Academic Diploma and the students enrolled in the 2nd year Second Level Academic Diploma
- **February 05, 2027** – only students enrolled in the 1st year Second Level Academic Diploma. IED reserves the right to anticipate this date in case there are only students who applied for the scholarship that have all achieved the First Level title before January 31, 2027

All the provisional ranking lists will be published on the IED website (<https://www.ied.edu/admissions/study-in-italy/scholarship-right-to-education>) and on the Student Desk Right to Education portal personal page.

Students who have submitted their application by the deadline set out in this call will be:

- **“eligible”** if in possession of all requirements;
- **“ineligible”** in the absence of one or more requirements.

Benefits are granted only to “eligible” students, according to their place on the ranking list, starting from the top and proceeding in descending order until available resources are depleted.

Moreover, on the basis of actual allocation of benefits, students will then be:

- **“eligible beneficiaries,”** namely, students awarded a scholarship;
- **“eligible non-beneficiaries,”** namely, students in possession of all requirements but not awarded a scholarship.

Students who are “eligible non-beneficiaries” can obtain the scholarship only if and when additional resources become available.

Any appeals regarding the provisional ranking lists **must be presented to IED** through the dedicated section of the **Student Desk Right to Education portal no later than 15 days from the date of publication of said ranking lists**.

Appeals must relate to any evaluations by the DSU IED office deemed erroneous by the student, and must be accompanied by appropriate documentation that objectively shows grounds for the appeal, without prejudice to the IED’s incontestable right to discretionary evaluation of appeals. The outcome of appeals will be communicated directly to the applicants by e-mail in the form envisaged for the publication of the ranking lists.

On completion of procedures relating to any appeals, the final ranking lists will be published no sooner than:

- **December 18, 2026** – all students enrolled in the First Level Academic Diploma and the students enrolled in the 2nd year Second Level Academic Diploma
- **February 26, 2027** – only students enrolled in the 1st year Second Level Academic Diploma. IED reserves the right to anticipate this date in case there are only students who applied for the scholarship that have all achieved the First Level title before January 31, 2027

10. ASSIGNMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND PAYMENT TERMS - REVOCATION OF THE BENEFIT

- **Students enrolled in the 1st year – First Level Academic Diploma**

The first instalment of the scholarship (equal to 50% of the total) according to and depending on the remittance of funds by Regione Lombardia, will be paid to eligible beneficiaries

(students awarded a scholarship) by **December 31, 2026**.

The second instalment will be paid only to students who achieve **at least 40** credits by **August 10, 2027**.

Scholarships will be revoked for students enrolled in the 1st year – First Level Academic Diploma who fail to achieve at least 40 credits by **November 30, 2027**. Students will be obliged to repay the amount received in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the scholarship).

- **Students enrolled in the 2nd year – First Level Academic Diploma**
- **Students enrolled in the 2nd year – Second Level Academic Diploma**

The first instalment of the scholarship (equal to 50% of the total) according to and depending on the remittance of funds by Regione Lombardia, will be paid to the eligible beneficiaries (students awarded a scholarship) by **December 31, 2026**.

The second instalment will be paid only to students who achieve **at least 100** credits by **August 10, 2027**. Student can use **5-point bonuses** to achieve this requirement.

Scholarships will be revoked for students enrolled in the 2nd year First Level and Second Level Academic Diploma who fail to achieve at least **100 credits** by **November 30, 2027**. Students will be obliged to repay the amount received in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the scholarship).

- **Students enrolled in the 3rd year – First Level Academic Diploma**

The first instalment of the scholarship (equal to 50% of the total) according to and depending on the remittance of funds by Regione Lombardia, will be paid to the eligible beneficiaries (students awarded a scholarship) by **December 31, 2026**.

The second instalment will be paid only to students who achieve **at least 160** credits by **August 10, 2027**. Students can use **12-point bonuses** to achieve this requirement.

Scholarships will be revoked for students enrolled in the 3rd year First Level Academic Diploma who fail to achieve at least 160 credits by **November 30, 2027**. Students will be obliged to repay the amount received in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the scholarship).

- **Students enrolled in the 1st year – Second Level Academic Diploma**

The first instalment of the scholarship (equal to 50% of the total) according to and depending on the remittance of funds by Regione Lombardia, will be paid to eligible beneficiaries (students awarded a scholarship) by **March 15, 2027**. IED reserves the right to anticipate this date in case there are only students who applied for the scholarship that have all achieved the First Level title before January 31, 2027.

The second instalment will be paid only to students who achieve **at least 40** credits by **August 10, 2027**.

Scholarships will be revoked for students enrolled in the 1st year – Second Level Academic Diploma who fail to achieve at least 40 credits by **November 30, 2027**. Students will be obliged to repay the amount received in the first instalment (equal to 50% of the total value of the scholarship).

In case of total revocation of the benefit, the student shall refund all sums received to IED. It is possible to stipulate with the student agreements concerning the recovery of the sums, including in instalments.

Failure to pay, partially or totally, of the amount owed will lead to the start of procedures for forced debt recovery, as well as the block of the academic career of the student until payment of the aforementioned sums.

In the event of partial revocation, the student loses the right to the full amount of the scholarship. If they meet the merit requirements by **30 November 2027**, they will retain the amount already paid as the first instalment, but they will **not be entitled to any further payments** for the **2026/2027 Academic Year**.

Students who do not cash in their scholarship as awarded by **December 31, 2027** will lose the right to collect the sum of money awarded, but will retain the benefits that come with being a “beneficiary” of a scholarship.

Eligible beneficiaries will receive payment of the scholarship via:

- **bank transfer to a bank account in their name or of which they are a joint account holder.**
- **reloadable prepaid card with an IBAN CODE (e.g. Postepay Evolution) in their name or of which they are a joint account holder.**

All eligible beneficiaries are therefore obliged to communicate their bank details to the IED DSU office, updating the details in the dedicated section of STUDENT DESK Right to Education.

Scholarships are awarded to foreign students from non-European Union countries in compliance with the regional provision established by the Decree issued by the General Directorate of Education, Training and Employment no. 21650, dated 13/11/2002.

11. INADMISSIBILITY AND FORFEITURE

Scholarships cannot be combined with similar forms of financial aid, provided by IED or other public or private bodies, with scholarships awarded by other universities or institutes pursuant to d.lgs. no. 68/2012, with scholarships for foreign students issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, or with free accommodation in colleges, residences

or boarding not managed by IED: in such cases, students will have to choose between the IED grant and the other financial aid. In case of a partial benefit from another financial aid, the student will be able to receive an IED scholarship a proportional measure.

Students forfeit their right to the scholarship if they:

1. incur disciplinary sanctions over and above written warnings for offences carried out against IED;
2. do not provide IED with the original documents required, within the indicated deadlines, for checks on the truthful nature of self-certification and certifications produced, namely they do not consent or they hinder or circumvent, even though negligence, verification of truthfulness pursuant to art. 71, para. 4, DPR 445/2000;
3. submit an application to withdraw from studies or transfer to another university during the academic year 2026/2027.
4. not meet the merit requirement for the confirmation of benefits by **November 30, 2027** (as stated in chapter 4 point 4.1 and chapter 10)
5. does not obtain the First Level Degree by **January 31, 2027** (as stated in chapter 4 point 4.1)

12. TRANSFERS

Students transferring from another university after the start of the academic year 2026/2027 must ask the DSU office at their original university to send IED the application originally made to that university, provided that it was presented within the term envisaged by the application call. The regularisation of the transfer must be completed before publication of the final ranking lists by IED. Admission to the ranking depends on possession of the requirements regarding merit, income, and the availability of resources.

In case of transfer to another university after the beginning of the academic year 2026/2027, students can ask the IED DSU office, no later than November 30, 2026, to send their application to the university to which they are transferring. In this case, students will not be entitled to the scholarship issued by IED.

13. CHECKS ON THE TRUTHFUL NATURE OF ECONOMIC DECLARATION PROVIDED (D.P.R 445/2000, art. 71, para. 4)

With reference to the determination of the economic conditions for access to benefits, IED will only accept certifications issued by competent entities, namely substitute declarations complete with the express consent of the interested party pursuant to D.P.R. 445/2000, art. 71, para. 4 and subsequent amendments, and will verify students' declarations as follows:

- automatic checks on all students belonging to a household declaring no income;
- random checks on 20% of those eligible to receive DSU benefits.

After proper and accurate verification processes, in the event of false declarations or discrepancies between tax declarations and declarations made for access to DSU benefits, any erroneously assigned benefits will be revoked.

Moreover, in case of untruthful declarations, the sanctions envisaged by art. no. 75 and no. 76 of D.P.R. no. 445/2000, and those envisaged by D. Lgs. n. 68/2012, art. 10, will be applied, requiring students to pay a sum the equivalent of three times the amount received. Students will also lose their right to obtain other benefits for the entire duration of the study course, without prejudice to the imposition of disciplinary sanctions and reporting to the competent judicial authorities for consideration of any criminal offences.

14. INFORMATION ON THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA AND THE RIGHTS OF THE DECLARANT PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/678 ("GDPR")

In relation to the personal data of data subjects acquired by IED through declarations made by the subjects and documents presented by them, note:

- a) the Data Controller of data subjects' personal data is IED Istituto Europeo di *Design* Spa - *Società benefit* with registered office in Milan, via Bezzecca, 5;
- b) the Data Protection Officer is Ecoconsult s.r.l., with registered office in Milan, via Goldoni, 1, contactable by e-mail at: dpo@ied.it;
- c) declarations and documents must be provided to enable verification of the economic situation of the student's household, requirements for access to the benefit and calculation of the scholarship, according to the criteria reported in this application call;
- d) data are collected and used by IED DSU Office, also using information technology, for the sole purpose of drafting the ranking lists and providing the benefits requested and, in any case, for legal purposes;
- e) data may be exchanged between institutions including the Italian Ministry of Finance and the Guardia di Finanza financial police for relevant checks;
- f) students can contact IED at any time to verify their personal data and to request the updating, integration, rectification or deletion of this data. They can request the blocking

of the data and oppose its processing, if processed unlawfully (from art. 15 to art. 22 of GDPR) **Updates, rectifications, integration and deletions will affect the ranking list only if carried out by November 6, 2026.**
